Instructions for Cleaning Small Culture Spills

- 1. Inform your instructor. Follow the procedure for cleaning small spills of culture (BSL1 and BSL2 levels) as follows.
- 2. Wear a lab coat, disposable gloves, safety glasses or a face shield.
- Soak paper towel(s) in an appropriate disinfectant (70% ethanol/fresh 10% bleach solution) and place over spill area.
- 4. Working from the outer edges into the centre, clean the spill area with fresh towels soaked in disinfectant.
- 5. Be sure to decontaminate any areas or surfaces that you suspect to be affected by the spill. Allow 10 minutes of contact time.
- 6. Place the paper towels and gloves into a biohazard bag and sterilize them by autoclaving.
- 7. Dispose off any contaminated clothing properly.
- 8. Wash your hands with a disinfectant soap.
