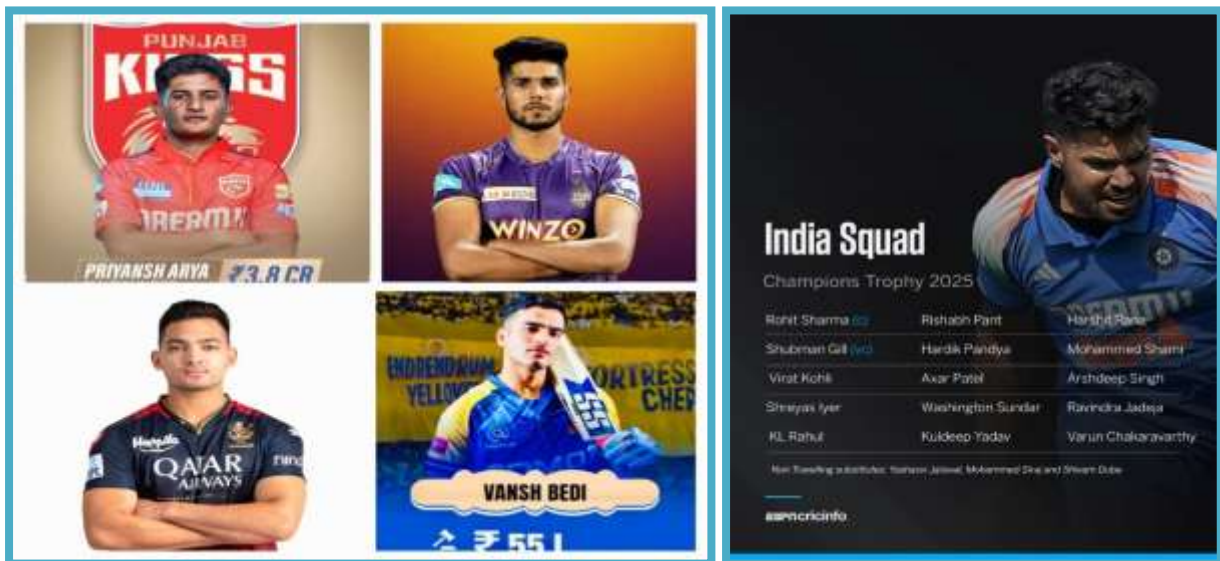
Events and Achievements

Additionally, in the North Zone Inter-University Cricket (Men) Tournament 2024-25, several students have been selected to represent Delhi University: Yashjeet (Captain), Jasmeet Nain, Vipul Saini, Arjun Rapria, Parteek Sehrawat, Aditya Chaudhary, Ajay Yadav, Kabir Bishnoi, Sumit Chikara, Kaushal Suman, and Prince Rana.

3. Furthermore, we take great pride in Harshit Rana, a student of Swami Shraddhanand College, who has consistently demonstrated exceptional performance over the years. His dedication and perseverance have earned him an India ODI cap, making him the first student from our college to represent the country in all three game formats. Our student Harshit Rana was selected for the Indian Cricket Team for the Zimbabwe tour, making history as the first-ever student from Swami Shraddhanand College to represent the country at the international level.



4. In a momentous occasion, Harshit Rana received his Test Cap for India in the highly anticipated Border-Gavaskar Trophy against Australia, marking a significant milestone for our college.

5. Two of our students, Harshit Rana and Hrithik Shokeen, were selected to play in the prestigious BCCI Duleep Trophy, representing Team C and Team D, respectively.

6. The Delhi Senior Team for the Ranji Trophy included six outstanding players from our college: Yash Dhull, Sumit Mathur, Dhruv Kaushik, Anuj Rawat, Mayank Rawat, and Hrithik Shokeen.

7. Col C.K. Nayudu Trophy: The Delhi Cricket Team announced an 18-member squad for the upcoming Col C.K. Nayudu Trophy, with six players from Swami Shraddhanand College making it to the final selection: Priyansh Arya, Yugal Saini, Ayush Doseja, Arpit Rana, Agrim Sharma, and Parteek.

8. Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy: Six of our players were selected to represent Delhi in the Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy, showcasing their talent on a competitive platform. The selected players are Priyansh Arya, Mayank Rawat, Anuj Rawat, Yash Dhull, Dhruv Kaushik, and Vansh Bedi.

9. Border-Gavaskar Trophy 2024-25: The BCCI announced its 18-member squad for the Border-Gavaskar Trophy, with Harshit Rana and Nitish Kumar Reddy earning their maiden Test call-ups, further solidifying our college's reputation in cricket.

10. Under-23 Cricket Success: In a thrilling Delhi Under-23 match, our students played a pivotal role in securing a crucial victory.
