

ANNUAL REPORT(2022-2023)


TEACHER-IN-CHARGE: Dr S K Sagar







DAY 2 OF ZOO – UMANG (17THMARCH, 2023)


By this seminar on anger management students learnt kills to better understand and manage their emotions, particularly when it comes to dealing with anger.
