The campus is tobacco free and prohibits such illegal activities strictly by putting signboards within the campus. The campusis green and has beautiful landscaping. Proper checking of I-Cards is done, and visitors register is maintained at the main gate. There is a separate parking area for students and faculty vehicles. A bank is present within the college campus. The whole building is under electronic surveillance and CCTV cameras are installed at all important places such as the parking area, corridors, library, administrative block, exam branch, bank, reception etc.


The entry of vehicles is strictly prohibited in the campus. Parking is Various types of activities like cleanliness and plantation drives, lectures, Quiz, essay writing and poster competitions and important environmental days celebrations, etc are organized in college campus for encouragingthe students to maintain the campus eco-friendly and sustainable. The Campus encourages therestriction on use of single use plastics (SUPs) and enhancing use of Stainless Steel, metallic andglass bottles despite disposables items. The NSS of the college perform various activities to promote environmental protection and development such as donation drives, collection drives and awareness drives.

The campus has vast flora and fauna. All types of waste, whether biodegradable and non-biodegradable, are managed properly. The college has a separate area devoted to **Botanical andherbal garden.** In 2020, one acre of land of the campus is devoted for the development of "SaghanVann" (small dense forest).

The college is equipped with an on-grid rooftop "Solar Power Plant" of capacity 50 KW to fulfill the target of renewable solar energy potential under national solar mission. The solar power plant was inaugurated on 24th Nov. 2020, which has reduced the dependency on the power grid and is able to support the electricity requirements of the college. After installation of the solar power plant, the cost of expenditure on electricity bill is reduced by one fourth. The college community is constantly working in preserving the environment and has pledged to maintain the environmental sanctity for future generations.

In evening there was a plant adoption event where each volunteer adopted a plant to take care of






# KALP TRUH PLANTATION


#### MIYAWAKI PLANTATION
