## Report

### NEP,2020 Taskforce Committee, SSN College, DU

In order to understand and implement the futuristic and more inclusive National Education Policy, 2020 in the institution, the college recommended the name of 9 faculty members of the college to attend the Short-Term Course Titled "Implementation of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020" organised by Centre For Professional Development in Higher Education (CPDHE) from October 20,2021 to October 26,2021.

Subsequently, the institution formed a committee titled "NEP-2020 Taskforce Committee" on November 11, 2021 to make aware and implement the NEP-2020 among the teachers and students in the institution. The committee was formed with 13 Faculty Members of the college. (Annexure attached)

Hereafter, the committee undertook many programmes to increase awareness among teachers and students regarding NEP-2020 and to inculcate employable skills in the students of the institution.

The NEP-2020 Taskforce Committee in collaboration with Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan nyas conducted two workshops namely "Vocational and Skill based education in NEP, 2020" on November 19, 2021 and "NEP,2020: Integrated approach to language, art and culture for learner's holistic development" on November25, 2021 to familiarize the students and teachers of the institution with different dimensions of NEP, 2020. (Annexure attached)

The NEP, 2020 Taskforce Committee in collaboration with Shiksha Sanskriti Utthan Nyas also organised One Day National Seminar titled "Indian Knowledge System and NEP, 2020" on December 6, 2021. The main objective of the seminar was to highlight the roadmap of 21<sup>st</sup> Century laid down by National education Policy, 2020 wherein the top priority is to recreate our traditional knowledge, to synergise it with art, culture and language and to provide solutions top many contemporary challenges through traditional knowledge systems. Faculty members and research scholars from different institutions presented their research papers on different dimensions of NEP,2020. There was total 20 Sub topics for research papers namely Role of Indian Knowledge System in Nation Building, Indian Knowledge System towards an Atmanirbhar Bharat, Indian Knowledge System and Human Values, Opportunities and Challenges in implementation of NEP,2020, Indian Knowledge System: pride of India, Role of Teachers in the implementation of NEP,2020, etc. (Annexure attached)

The NEP, 2020 Taskforce Committee organised three skill enhancement workshops. The first workshop titled "Analysing Social Media and Online Advertising" was organised on September 2,2022. Second workshop entitled "Data Visualisation" conducted on September 9,2022 and third workshop titled "Project Finance" on September 16,2022. (Annexure attached)

NEP, 2020 Taskforce Committee, Swami Shraddhananda College, University of Delhi in collaboration with Delhi State Legal Services Authority started an Online Add-On Course on "Legal Awareness" for its students from 15th September, 2022 to 26th September, 2022. However, the opening ceremony of this Add-On Course was held in the college campus on 15th September,2022. The main objective behind this course was to spread legal

literacy/awareness about the important laws/products and DSLSA/DLSA among the young generation. This add-on course received registration from 180 participants. The course included 10 sessions including a virtual field trip. To assess students' understanding with topics, the MCQ questionnaire was prepared and the same Google link was shared with students after the related session. Total 135 Students successfully completed this Add-on course and were provided Course completion certificates in the valedictory session. (Annexure attached)

On September 28,2022, an educational seminar was organised on the topic "Profile Building and Young Leaders Program" to help them build a successful profile and career path in life. (Annexure attached)

An excursion program "Women's Jail Visit, Tihar" was organised on March 7, 2023. Five girl students from college went for this visit. Students got a glimpse of the internal functioning of the Jail authorities and living conditions of the inmates from close-up. (Annexure attached)

NEP 2020 aims to inculcate professional and technical skills as a part of holistic development. With a view to attain this, institution is offering a pool of Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Value Addition Courses (VAC) and Ability Enhancement Courses (AECC).

In order to offer these courses, committees for successful implementation of SEC, VAC and AECC were formed in the college.

On October 20,2022, a committee of six faculty members from the college was formed to implement the SEC Courses in the college as per NEP,2020. (Annexure attached).

Institution offered a bundle of 16 SEC courses to its first semester students and 110 SEC courses to its second semester students in academic year 2022-23. (Annexure attached)

Institution offered a bundle of 16 VAC courses to its first semester students and 18 VAC courses to its second semester students in academic year 2022-23. (Annexure attached). These courses have been decided in the meetings held on October 2, 2022 for First semester and on March 10, 2023 for second semester by Four faculty members of the college. (Minutes of the meeting attached)

A Series of National Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs)/ Refresher Courses were attended by eight faculty members from the college which was organised by University of



Delhi in collaboration with GAD-TLC, SGTB Khalsa College for capacity building towards NEP-2022 based Skill Enhancement Courses. (Annexure attached)

In order to successfully implement the Value Addition Courses (VAC) in the College, 16 faculty members from the college attended the workshop organised by University of Delhi. (Annexure attached)



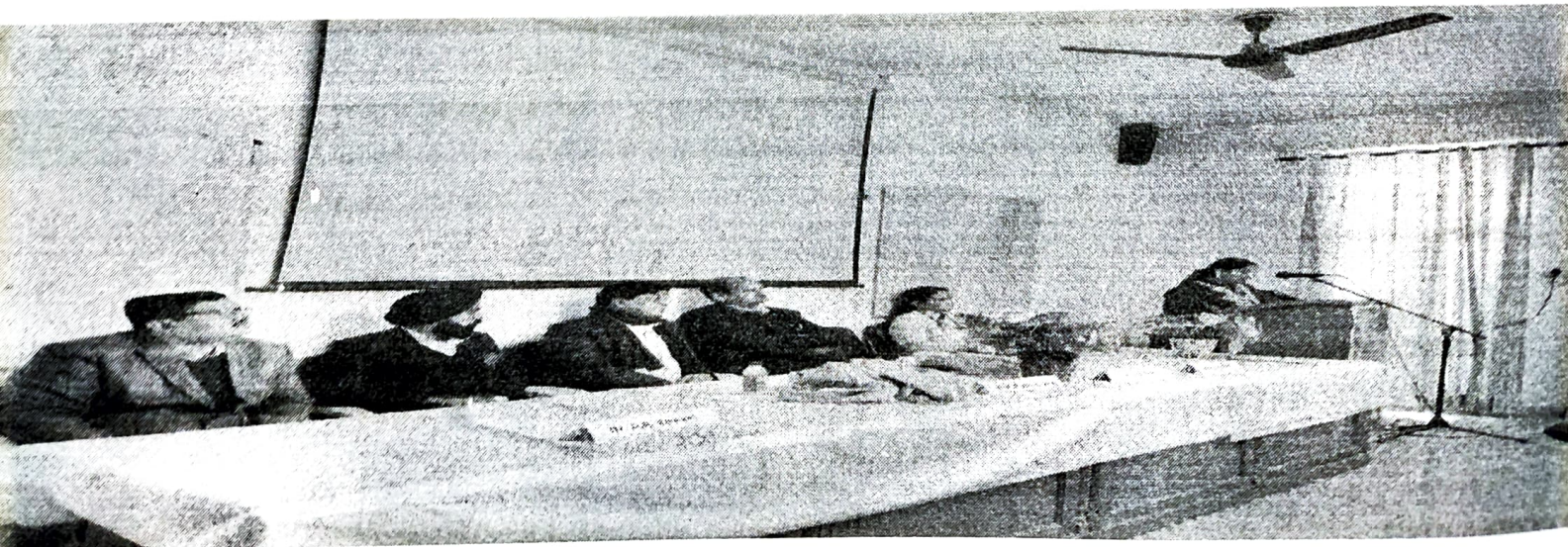

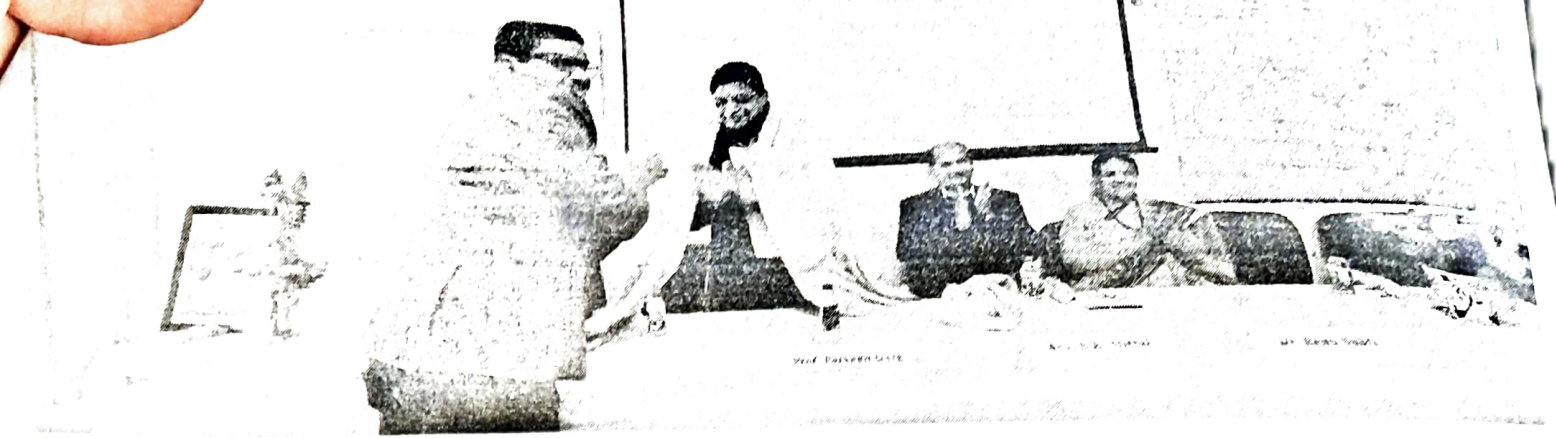
This event was held on January 27,2023 at 11 am in seminar hall of Swami Shraddhanand College, University of Delhi.

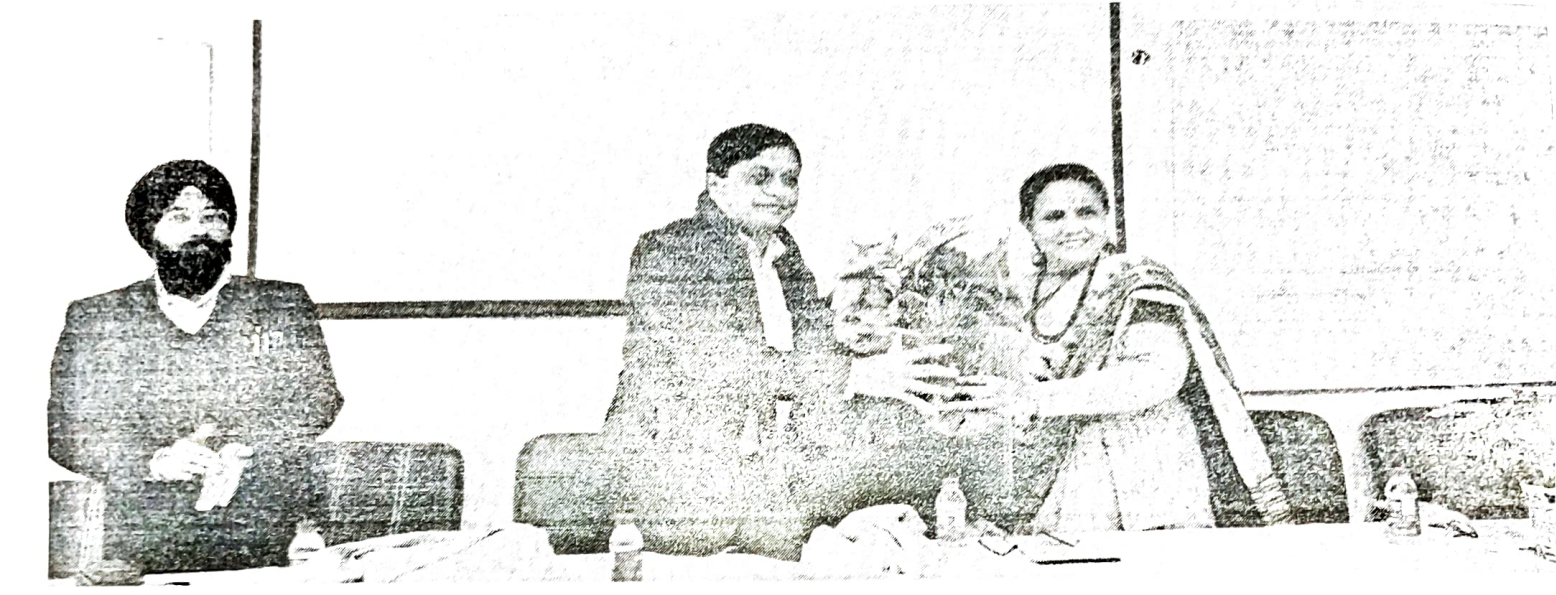

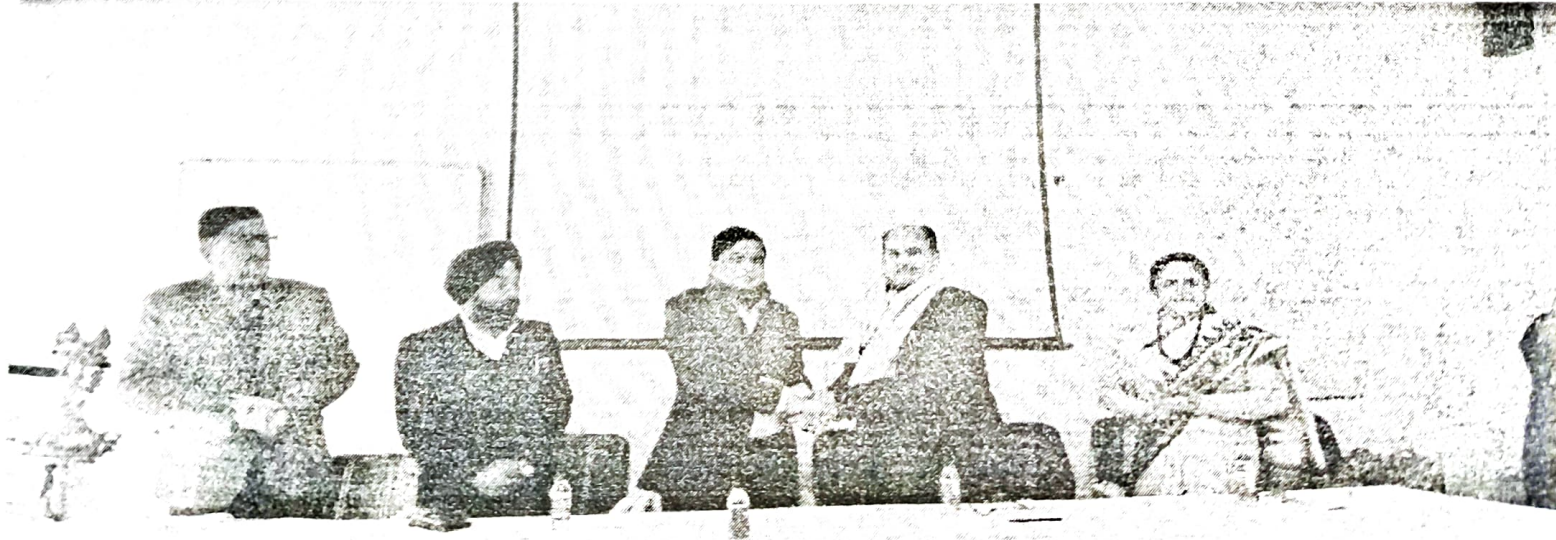

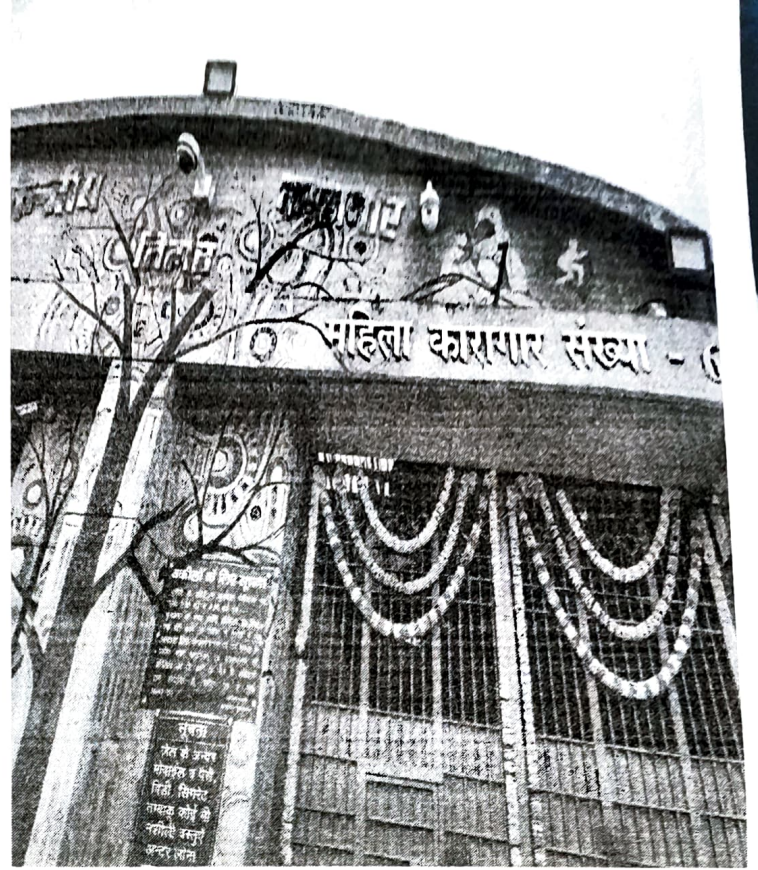
The inmates were also doing tailoring and embroidery work. Students also saw Jails creche where basic education is provided to kids above the age of 3 years.




