BRIEF INTRODUCTION OF THE SPEAKERS:

1) Sh. Bharat Parashar

Sh. Bharat Parashar, Additional Session Judge joined Delhi Judicial Service in the year 1992 and worked at different positions both on the civil as well as criminal side. Thereafter, in January 2006 he was promoted to Delhi Higher Judicial Service and has worked at different positions both on the Judicial and Administrative sides.

In the year 2014, he was appointed as Special Judge by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to preside over coal scam cases trial.

Sh. Bharat Parashar has now posted as Member Secretary, DSLSA since 27th March, 2022.

2) Sh. Sushant Changotra

Sh. Sushant Changotra is an officer of Delhi Higher Judicial Services and is presently posted as Special Secretary. Mr. Changotra did B. LLB from Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar in year 2002. Thereafter he did LLM from Kurkshehra University. Initially Mr. Changotra joined Haryana Civil Service (Judicial) in year 2008. Thereafter he joined PCS (Judicial). In the year 2009, he joined as DJS officer in Delhi Judiciary and promoted as DHJS in year 2019. He has been posted both in Civil & Criminal jurisdiction in these 13 years. He has authored a novel which was published in 2020. On 20th July, 2022, he joined Delhi State Legal Services Authority as the Special Secretary.

3) Sh. Sumeet Anand

Sh. Sumeet Anand, is an officer of Delhi Judicial services, Batch of 2013. He was selected as a Judicial officer in Delhi at the age of 25. In his tenure of service so far, in the last 7 years, Sh. Sumeet Anand has discharged his duties as Metropolitan Magistrate at Karkardooma Courts & Patiala House Courts. Sh. Sumeet Anand completed his schooling from Vivekanand School, Anand Vihar with humanities and social sciences as the core subjects with record breaking marks. Thereafter, he completed his B.A.LLB from New Law College, Bharti Vidyapeeth University, Pune in the year 2010. Prior to joining the Delhi Judicial Services in the year 2013, he was a practising lawyer in Delhi High court and District courts. He also practiced, for about an year in Madhya Pradesh High court, bench at Gwalior. As a practicing Advocate Sh. Sumeet Anand practiced in various jurisdictions in different courts mainly dealing with criminal matters. With effect from 19/11/2020 Sh. Anand has Joined his duties as Full Time Secretary of District Legal Services Authority, New Delhi District, at Patiala House Courts. On 20th July, 2022, he joined Delhi State Legal Services Authority as the Additional Secretary.

4) Ms. Harshita Mishra

Ms. Harshita Mishra has done her B.A. Economics (Hons.) from Shri Ram College of Commerce and LLB from Campus Law Centre, Delhi University. She completed LLM from Indian Law Institute, Delhi in March, 2015 and was awarded two gold medals, for being the overall topper and for securing highest marks in Criminal Law.

She also received UGC JRF certificates twice. Thereafter, she joined Jharkhand Judicial Service in July, 2015, where she worked for a brief period of four months. After this, she joined Delhi Judicial Service in December, 2015.

Before being appointed as Secretary, Litigation, Delhi State Legal Services Authority. She has presided over Civil Court in Tis Hazari Court, Mahila Court in Karkardooma Court and Digital NI Court in Saket Court. She has also worked in the capacity of Secretary, DLSA, East District, Karkardooma Court.

5) Dr. K B Rai

Sh. K B Rai was Former Advisor, Administrative Reforms Dept., Government of Delhi. He has 3 reputed degrees in his credit namely M.A in Public Administration and Philosophy, LLB and Ph. D.

Dr. K B Rai is Working on RTI since 2001 when it was first enacted for Delhi. He has been associated with implementation of RTI Act, 2005 as nodal officer for Delhi Government as a whole. He had Delivered over 500 lectures on RTI.

He has five books on RTI to his credit. Latest one on Sexual Harassment at Work place. He is very much devoted to Good Governance and Reforms.

6) Sh. Ashwani Kumar Mata

Sh. Ashwani Kumar Mata is Senior Advocate in Hon'ble Delhi High Court. He has practiced in Supreme Court of India, Delhi High Court and other High Courts; Tribunals, Commissions and Arbitration. He has done LL.B from Faculty of Law, University of Delhi in 1976 and B. Sc (Hons.) from Elphinstone College, University of Bombay in 1973. As a Designated Senior Advocate, he regularly appears in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, several Indian High Courts, and a variety of Tribunals and Commissions including Enquiry Commissions in constitutional, corporate, civil and criminal matters and gives advice on a variety of legal. Having extensively dealt with and advised on de-mergers, acquisitions, mergers and being fully familiar with the provisions of FERA and FEMA, he has advised on all aspects of cross-border contracts and investment policies including issues concerning customs, repatriation, foreigners and the legal regime applicable to them etc. He has Acted as a Senior Mediator with the Delhi High Court Mediation Centre and mediated in civil and criminal matters referred by the Supreme Court of India and the Delhi High Court. He has been a regular guest lecturer at the Department of Management Studies, University of Roorkee and the Staff Training Collage of Union Bank of India.

7) Ms. Isha Singh

Ms. Isha Singh completed her schooling from Presentation Convent, Sr. Sec. School, Delhi in the year 2012. Thereafter, she pursued her B.A., L.L.B. (Hons.) from Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Patiala, Punjab and graduated as a gold medalist in the year 2017. She joined the Delhi Judicial Services in July 2019 and has since worked as Metropolitan Magistrate specifically dealing with Cheque Bounce Cases. On 27.04.2022, she was posted as Full Time Secretary, District Legal Service Authority, South-East, Saket Courts. She is an avid reader and is committed to the cause of providing access to legal services to everyone.

8) Sh. Rishabh Kapoor

Sh. Rishabh Kapoor completed his matriculation in year 2007 and higher secondary education in year 2009 from Cambridge Foundation School, Delhi. Thereafter, did BALLB (H) from Vivekananda Institute of Professional Studies affiliated to Indraprastha University (GGSIPU), Delhi in year 2014.

He completed his LLM from Kurukshetra University in year 2016. Cracked Himachal Pradesh Judicial Services Examination in year 2016 and had distinction of getting third position in the examination. I have worked as Metropolitan Magistrate, Central District, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi and dealt with criminal cases pertaining to jurisdiction of PS Rajinder Nagar and IP Estate.

He joined as Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, West w.e.f. 27.04.2022.

9) Mr. Lalit Kumar

Mr. Lalit Kumar is presently posted as Secretary-II, Central District Legal Services Authority, Rouse Avenue Court Complex. 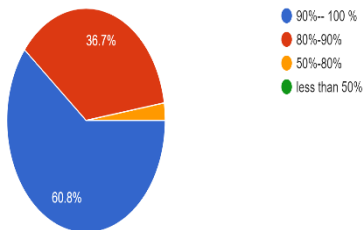

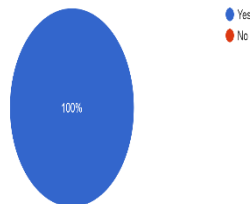

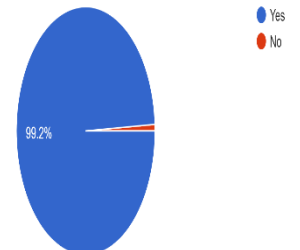
