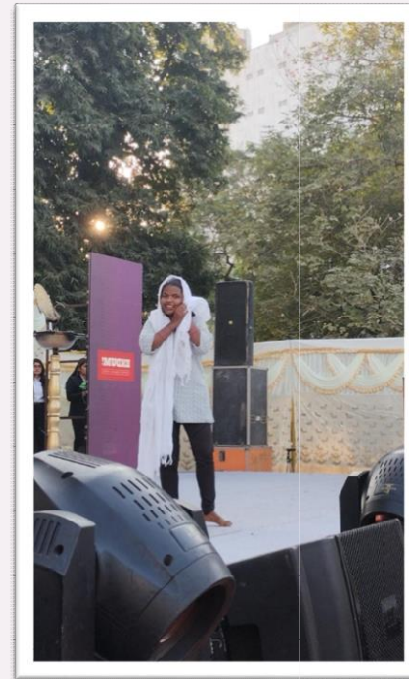
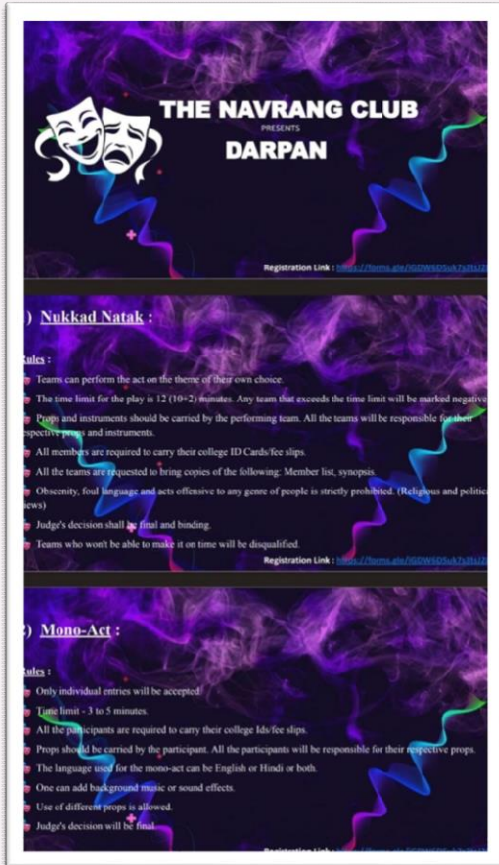


4. DELHI TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY

School of Drama.

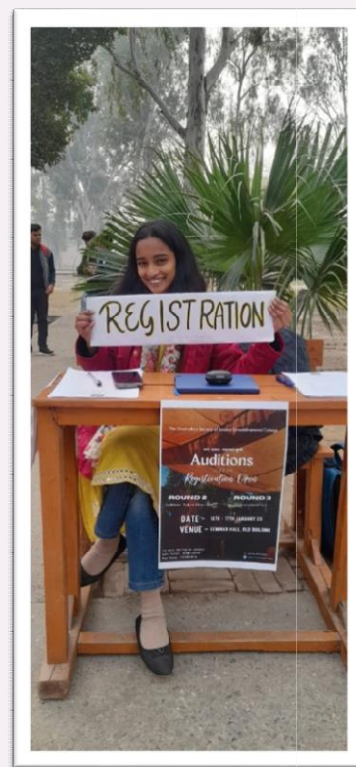
AUDITIONS 2023
