

SSN college library regularly updates its collection and added more than 2500 books every year. More than 450 users visit the library per day for different needs.

The Swami Shraddhanand College Library is a fully automated library with library management software SOUL 3.0 with its various modules. A web-based OPAC is installed through which users can search the required collection and their location in the library with various search options.
