The 1 DAS National Cadet Corps (NCC) instills essential values such as character, comradeship, discipline, leadership, secularism, adventure spirit, sportsmanship, and selfless service among 160 cadets. These qualities empower students to contribute meaningfully to the Prime Minister's vision of Vikshit Bharat. To achieve this, cadets undergo rigorous training in defense and adventure skills while actively participating in social service and community development initiatives throughout the academic year 2024-25. This year, our NCC unit achieved the second position in the Inter-Institute Competition of Group B, demonstrating commendable performance and dedication.
