Regarding Registration for Generic Elective Courses (GE), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Value Addition Courses (VAC), & Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) for Semester I (Academic Session 2025-26)

This is to inform to all the students of Semester I, that physical verification of documents is mandatory.

AFTER PHYSICAL VERIFICATION THE STUDENT WILL BE ALLOTTED COLLEGE ROLL NUMBER AND SECTION, which is compulsory to filling up of Google form for selection of Generic Elective Course (GEC), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Value Addition Courses (VAC), & Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)

Students are advised to fill in their GEC/SEC/VAC/AEC preferences after reading the guidelines and the syllabi carefully. **NO CHANGE WILL BE PERMISSIBLE AFTER YOUR RESPONSE EXCEPT TECHNICAL REASONS.**

THE LAST DATE FOR FILLING UP THE GOOGLE FORM HAS BEEN EXTENDED TILL AUGUST 26, 2025, 5:00 PM. NO FURTHER DATE WILL BE EXTENDED IN ANY CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND THE CLOSING DATE.

If students do not fill the google form for their GEC/SEC/VAC/AEC subjects, the college will allocate these subjects at its discretion, and no requests for changes in the allotted subjects will be entertained after the closing date.

Guidelines for GE, Semester I, Honors Courses:

1. It is mandatory for all the students of **All Hons** Courses of Semester-I to choose their options of the GE papers that they want to opt for the 2025-26 session (Odd semester, Semester-I).
2. The students are required to give their preferences of the GE papers offered by the different departments for the Semester-I of session 2025-26. **The College will allot the GE subject in case**

of wrong selection of paper or no response. Students will not be allowed to change their GE subjects at a later stage. Therefore, follow extreme care while choosing the options, as college does not guarantee for the allotment of the chosen preferences.

- You are requested to choose one Generic Elective Language(Gel) Hindi paper and Ability Enhancement Course-AEC for I semester as per your study level of Hindi language or any other Indian Language. You have to choose one Skill Enhancement Course(SEC) and One Value Added Course (VAC) from the list of paper floated by different departments.
This form is filled only once. No change will be permitted after filling this form, so please confirm your paper choice before submitting it.
- The students of all Hons. courses need to opt the subject of their interest offered by the **other departments (other than their core department)** i.e., If a student is in Semester-I of B. Com (H) than the student will choose a GE subject of his/her interest from Non-Commerce Department only and ViceVersa.**The students cannot choose the course offered by their own department. For Example: A Student pursuing B. Com(H) cannot opt the GE paper offered by the Commerce Department of the College.**
- Please also note that if a student wishes to have ‘Minor degree’ in any one discipline, then he/she is required to study 7 Generic Elective of the same department during the period of 4 years. A student can get minor degree only if he/she successfully completes 4 years of the undergraduate programmes.
Example: A student is enrolled in B.A.(Hons.) History and decides to pursue 4th year (Sem VII+ Sem VIII). If he successfully completes the 4th year, he/she will be awarded Major in History. In addition, if the student successfully completes seven GEs in Political Science, he/she will be awarded Minor in Political Science.

Guidelines for GE, Semester I, Programme Courses:

- It is mandatory for all the students of **B.A. (Prog.), Semester I**, to study the any one of GEL paper of **ENGLISH** compulsorily. The second course of same language must be studied in subsequent year.
Students of English+ Pol Science & English + History discipline will have the option of choosing the GE paper from the list of common pool of GE Courses except from English/ Pol science & English / History department respectively.

- It is mandatory for all the students of **B.Com. Programme, Semester I**, to study the GE Paper of Hindi Language compulsorily, depending upon their acquaintance with the Hindi at School level. Please note the following for your reference:

2055091001	Hindi A -Hindi Bhasha Aur Sahitya Ka Uddhav Aur Vikas	Studied Hindi upto Class XII
2055091002	Hindi B -Hindi Bhasha Aur Sahitya Ka Uddhav Aur Vikas	Studied Hindi upto Class X
2055091003	Hindi C -Hindi Bhasha Aur Sahitya Ka Uddhav Aur Vikas	Studied Hindi upto Class VIII

Also note that students who have **not studied Hindi in their school upto VIII Class**, will have the option of choosing the GE paper from the list of common pool of GE Courses except from Commerce department.

- It is mandatory for all the students of **B.Sc. Programme, Semester I**, to select GE course except their parent disciplines for example BSc, Life science and Applied Life Science GE must be from common pool except Botany, Zoology and Chemistry. Similarly B.Sc. Programme Physical Science must choose GE Course except from Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry department.

Guidelines for Skill Enhancement Courses, Value Addition Courses, and Ability Enhancement Courses for Semester-I

It is mandatory for all the students of all courses of Semester I to choose their options for Value-Added Course (VAC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) that they want to opt for the 2025-26 session (Semester-I).

The students are required to give preferences of VAC, preferences of SEC and register for their compulsory AEC. The college will allot the VAC and SEC subjects on a first come first serve basis.

Students will not be allowed to change their AEC/VAC/SEC subjects at a later stage. Therefore, follow extreme care while choosing your options, as college does not guarantee for the allotment of the chosen preferences.

The student can choose any paper offered by any department.

Students are advised to go through the Syllabi of the Value-Added Courses (VAC), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), before choosing their options.

The students of B.A. (Hons.) and B.Sc. (Hons.) and B.Sc.(Prog.) will be studying Environmental Science: Theory into Practice – Part I in Semester I as their compulsory AEC.

The students of B.Com. (Hons), B. Com (Prog.) and B.A.(Prog.) will be studying an Indian Language in their Semester I. The College offers only Hindi as an Indian Language. Please note:

Hindi A is for students who have studied the language upto class XII.

Hindi B is for students who have studied the language upto class X.

Hindi C is for students who have studied the language upto class VIII and below.

Hindi E is for students who have not studied Hindi at all.

The students who wish to study any AEC Indian language (other than Hindi), are required to send an application to room no 122 mentioning your Roll Number, Course, Contact Number, and AEC paper that you wish to study in Semester I after filling the google form.

In case you opt for an AEC-Indian Language not offered by the College, you will have to attend classes in any other college belonging to the Cluster Colleges of the University of Delhi. The fulfillment of your choice depends on the terms and conditions set by the host college.
