Important Guidelines

For Hons. Courses – GE:

Students must select GE papers offered by departments **other than their own core department.**

Students should choose preferences carefully, as allotment will depend on availability and the College cannot guarantee the first preference.

Students interested in pursuing a **Minor Degree** must complete **seven GEs in the same discipline** during the four-year UG programme, subject to the applicable University rules.

For B.A. (Programme):

Students must study an **English GE/GEL** in Semester I. The available options include **English Fluency-I** and **Digital Communication**, as applicable.

For B.Com. (Programme):

Hindi is compulsory as the GE in Semester I, according to the student's prior level of study:

- **Hindi A:** Studied up to Class XII
- **Hindi B:** Studied up to Class X
- **Hindi C:** Studied up to Class VIII

Students who have not studied Hindi up to Class VIII may choose from the common GE pool, excluding Commerce.

For B.Sc. (Programme):

GE must be selected from outside the student's parent disciplines. For example, Life Science/Applied Life Science students cannot choose Botany, Zoology or Chemistry; Physical Science students cannot choose Mathematics, Physics or Chemistry.

SEC, VAC & AEC

All Semester I students must register for their **SEC, VAC and AEC** options. SEC and VAC allotment will be made on a **first-come, first-served basis**, subject to availability. No changes will be permitted later.

Students are advised to review the relevant syllabi before making their choices.

AEC:

- **B.A. (Hons.), B.Sc. (Hons.) and B.Sc. (Programme):** Environmental Science: *Theory into Practice – Part I* is compulsory.
- **B.Com. (Hons.), B.Com. (Programme) and B.A. (Programme):** An Indian Language is compulsory. The College offers **Hindi A, B, C and E** according to the student's prior exposure to Hindi.

Students wishing to study an Indian language other than Hindi must submit an application to **Room No. 122** after filling the Google Form, mentioning their **Roll Number, Course, Contact Number and AEC choice**. Such choices will be subject to availability and the terms of the host/cluster college.

Students are advised to complete the process well before the deadline to avoid any last-minute difficulty.
